AGREEMENT:

By signing this Training/Handling Contract you, as, or on behalf of, the Customer, accept and acknowledge that:

1. You are the legal owner of the animals in question or you have the authority on behalf of the legal owners of the animal(s) in question to order Goods and/or Services from WF and to bind the Customer;
2. All information you have provided to WF on this Training/handling Contract is up to date, relevant and complete;
3. The Customer is bound to WF Terms and Conditions of Trade on the basis that they shall have continuing effect and the Customer's obligations under such Terms and Conditions of Trade shall not be terminable. The Customer will continue to be bound by all of the Terms and Conditions of Trade irrespective of whether, and the extent to which, any Goods and/or Services are provided by WF (directly or indirectly);
4. You have been provided with a current WF price list, or if you have not, it is your sole responsibility to request and obtain a price list from WF.
5. By signing this contract you are giving WF, and its employees, servants and agents permission to handle the animal and to train the animal how WF deems necessary. You understand that there are risks associated with training horses and although all care will be given we cannot be held responsible for any event leading to injury, sickness or death.
6. If the horse becomes a danger to people, animals and/or itself we reserve the right to relinquish permissible care. In which every effort to contact the owner will be made to make other arrangements.

The Customer accepts that equine farming carries inherent risks and variables that are outside the control of WF and which may affect the results achieved through use of WF Goods and/or Services. WF does not give, and its employees, servants and agents do not have the authority to give, any representation or warranty of any sort, whether express or implied, as to the results and/or performance to be achieved or expected from Goods and/or Services supplied by WF.

Wake Field Equestrian Estate reserves the right to:

- Catch and move any horse on the WF property.
- Call a vet out if a horse requires immediate veterinary attention. Every effort will be made to contact the horse's owner at that time. Owners are responsible for any Veterinary costs.
- Request owner's to worm horses in line with the WF worming schedule.
- Remove halters/ covers if animal welfare is hindered by these.
- Has the right to ask any customer to leave but will give 24 hours' notice of contract termination.
- Feed additional feed/supplements if supplied feed is not adequate, at the owners' expense.
- Stable horses that do not have adequate protection from the elements, at the owners' expense.

Owners Agreement:**Owners agree to:**

- Disclose ALL known issues (behavioral or otherwise) PRIOR to training commencing. Failure to do so may result in legal action.
- Have their animal fit and healthy prior to commencing training. This includes, but not limited to; Feet and teeth up to date, good physical condition, fit enough to commence the training required, no lameness, etc.
- Provide appropriate equipment for training. Correctly fitting saddle, bridle, etc.
- Provide covers to suit the conditions of the season **OR** have time charged for cleaning of horse, etc.
- Make their presence known to WF staff upon arrival.
- To pay, in full, all accounts owing including, but not limited to: float hire, grazing fees, stable use, hay, any damages caused by horse before horse leaves the property unless by prior arrangement.

- Take responsibility for their horses' environment by being aware of any issues or concerns and advising WF staff immediately of these.
- Read and abide by WF code of conduct which is available upon request.

Rules and Regulations:

Use of these facilities is at visitors own risk

- **Dogs are not permitted to be brought onto WF property.**
- Buildings/barns are strictly out of bounds unless accompanied by WF employees, servants or agents
- Issues or concerns are to be reported as soon as possible to WF.
This includes fencing / noxious weeds/ damaged facilities/ injuries or health issues of stock/ empty or dirty water troughs or any other concerns.
- Damages caused by owners, horses or owners guests to be reported immediately and the owner is responsible for damage repair costs.
- Any guest of horse owners are the responsibility of the owner. All guests need to be respectful of the property and horses.
- Animal Welfare Officers have permission to access WF property at any time.
- Invoices will be created fortnightly or at the end of your horses stay, whichever is shorter. Invoices must be paid by due date specified, otherwise additional costs may be applied.
